JCI Fluctuates: Between US Data, Powell's Testimony, and Financial Reports





Market Data


During last week, JCI closed at 6,742.58 (-5.16%). Foreign investors recorded net sell of 3.97 trillion (regular market) or 3.81 trillion net sell (all markets). The stocks that became foreign net buyers during the week were: BRIS (168.1B), BRMS (78.4B), AMMN (43.9B), BIPI (43.2B) & ICBP (41.4B). The stocks that became foreign net sellers during the week were: BMRI (2.27T), BBCA (839.9B), GOTO (283.3B), BBNI (198.6B), TPIA (146.7B). The weakening of JCI was due to foreign net sell on banking stocks, and MSCI announcement that PTRO, CUAN, BREN are not included in MSCI.

Over the next week US market movement will be influenced by the release of Inflation data on Wednesday which is expected to remain flat at 2.9% YoY, and for Core Inflation is expected to fall to 3.1% Yoy. On the other hand, there will also be Fed Powell Testimony where market participants are waiting for the next direction of monetary policy from the Fed. In addition, there will also be Retail Sales and PPI data to be released this week. Meanwhile, China has released Inflation data which recorded an increase to 0.5% YoY and Core Inflation recorded an increase to 0.7% MoM. In addition, we also suggest looking at other data such as M2 Money Supply, New Yuan Loans, and Outstanding Loan Growth.

While from Indonesia there will be the release of Consumer Confidence data which is expected to rise to 128, and there is also December Retail Sales data which is expected to grow to 3.7% YoY, as well as Property Price Index Q4 data which is expected to grow to 1.5% YoY. And we still recommend to pay attention to the release of earnings report which could be a sentiment for JCI movement.

The Growth of the Reference Stock Price Index by 1 Week%





JCI closed lower and breakdown support. Indicator from stochastic is bearish, MACD histogram is moving bearish (line is sloping) and volume is decreasing. Bearish scenario: If it moves bearish, JCI is expected to weaken to the support range 6,598 – 6,618. Bullish scenario: If JCI is able to move bullish, JCI has the opportunity strengthen to the resistance range 6,855 – 6,875.

Ticker: BSDE



(BSDE) Price closed higher with bullish candle. Price has the opportunity strengthen to the nearest resistance. Stochastic is golden cross potential, MACD histogram is moving negative direction (line is death cross potential) and volume is decreasing. If the price falls first, use a buy on weakness strategy in the support area. Confirmation to buy again if the candle is bullish, with the first target at level 960, next at 975. We recommend being careful if there is a bearish candle and a breakdown of the nearest support level in the range 885 – 895. (Trading Buy)

Entry Buy : 895 – 920 Target Price : 960 – 975 Support : 885 – 895

Ticker: DMMX



(DMMX) Price closed higher and breakup harmonic resistance (FR 61.80%). Price has the opportunity strengthen to the next resistance. Stochastic is death cross, MACD histogram is moving positive (line is bullish) and volume is increasing. If the price falls first, use a buy on weakness strategy in the support area. Confirmation to buy again if the candle is bullish, with the first target at level 266, next at 278. We recommend being careful if there is a bearish candle and a breakdown of the nearest support level in the range 248 – 252. (Trading Buy)

Entry Buy : 252 – 260 Target Price : 266 – 278 Support : 248 – 252

Cut loss : 246





Ticker: ICBP



(ICBP) Price closed higher and breakout resistance. Price has the opportunity strengthen to the next resistance. Stochastic is golden cross, MACD histogram is moving positive (line is bullish) and volume is increasing. If the price falls first, use a buy on weakness strategy in the support area. Confirmation to buy again if the candle is bullish, with the first target at level 11,775, next at 12,000. We recommend being careful if there is a bearish candle and a breakdown of the nearest support level in the range 10,975 - 11,075. (Trading Buy)

Entry Buy : 11,075 – 11,375 Target Price : 11,775 – 12,000 Support : 10,975 – 11,075

Cut loss : 10,950

Review Stock Recommendation last Week

ASSA: The price closed at 625 (-7.41%) and breakdown support, if successful cut loss at 650 is only -3.85%. Prices still have the opportunity to strengthen if price back to above support level. Last price closed with doji candle. Beware if the price breaks below new support at 610.

BRIS: The price managed touched our first target at 3,040, highest at 3,050 (+4.10%) and closed at 3,020 (+3.07%). Prices still have the opportunity to strengthen as long as the support level holds. Last price closed with bullish candle. Beware if the price breaks below the support.

INDF: The price closed at 7,650 (-2.55%) and still buying range. Prices still have the opportunity to strengthen as long as the support level holds. Last price closed with bullish candle. Beware if the price breaks below the support.
